### Special features and options

When building a box nativity scene, all styles and representations of the nativity are possible in principle, which we install into a high-quality box. There are three different box sizes available with or without doors, as corner boxes or straight boxes to choose from. As material for constructing the nativity representation, we mainly use Styrodur (expanded polystyrene), wood and cork bark. Lighting is an important component of these box nativities. Here LED light with a voltage of 12 volts is used. The figure size should be adapted to the overall size (up to max 15 cm depending on representation). Through an appealing background image, the representation gains corresponding depth and the background image is an essential element for a harmonious overall effect of this type of nativity scene. Box nativities are particularly suitable for winter representations because through sophisticated lighting these nativities radiate a particularly attractive atmosphere. Box nativities should be placed at eye level if possible. The snow box nativity is a specialty that originated in Wennis in the Pitztal. Have fun building!
