Special features and options

In the course "New Techniques" we mainly deal with the diverse possibilities that materials such as Styrofoam, Styrodur, Polystyrene etc. offer to nativity scene builders. Essentially, this course focuses on building a small demonstration model. The production of windows and doors for local and oriental nativity scenes in various forms, different types of walls and new plastering options are part of this course. Four different roof coverings made from Styrofoam and an authentic wood imitation complete the course program. An appropriate finishing of the demonstration model is also included as well as grouting the walls and brickwork. The use of different types of Styrofoam is also a topic in this course. The finished model is particularly suitable as a sample for any nativity scene workshop. Have fun with the course "New Techniques in Nativity Scene Construction"!
