Special features and options

In the "Gschalamandln" course, we create nativity figures from corn husks. Participants have the opportunity to produce individual figures up to complete nativity or folk art scenes made of corn husks, where imagination knows no bounds. The figures initially arise from a wire construction for which there is an exact instruction manual. This wire structure is subsequently wrapped with corn husks that give the figure its shape. Then the "raw figures" are covered with corn husks using a special technique. In combination with a small nativity scene made of roots and natural materials, this creates a total work of art that brings joy for generations. MATERIAL LIST: Sewing or darning needle sharp with as large an eye as possible (approx. 1cm, reserve needle is available from the course instructor), pins, pincushion, small scissors, curved nail clippers, small craft pliers, sewing or crochet yarn beige or white, small glue bottle with a small opening, ruler or measuring tape, towel, if available: larch bark, hairdryer and corn husks (leaves around the cob) Have fun at the "Gschalamandln" course!
