Special features and options

In the "Diorama Nativity Scene Building" course, we build nativity scenes in the style of the great Italian nativity scene makers such as Antonio Pigozzi, Nicolo Celegato, and others. The nativity scenes are built according to perspective principles and are made entirely of Styrodur. The diorama nativity scenes are installed in prefabricated balsa wood boxes (W 40 cm / D 40 cm / H 40 cm). Walls are scored with a pencil or small burning pens and dry-grouted. Terrain sections and rocks are coated with plaster and finished accordingly. Carefully positioned lighting using adjustable 12 V LED technology is also very important and gives the scenes a sunlit atmosphere. The distant mountains and hills are also built here, and only the sky is created as a painted surface. Suitable vegetation and finishing complete the nativity landscape and create an exceptional sense of spatial depth. With the right figures made of clay or wood, these "Italian peep-box nativity scenes" become especially charming unique pieces. Depending on the scene, figures measuring 6 - 9 cm can be used in this course. Enjoy building your diorama.
