 Objective: Independent painting of an oriental or local-style background image
 Requirements: Please bring: 1 sample board 60x80 cm, painting boards as needed (prime all boards with matte exterior emulsion paint), painting cloths, templates of the nativity scene outlines, a good photo of the nativity scene; brushes and paints can be purchased during the course.
 Included: Course including teaching materials and full board at the hut

 Lodging: Accommodation is in a shared room at the hut

Special features and options

In the course "Painting backgrounds for beginners", we start with a theoretical introduction. We deal with the core topics of naturalistic landscape painting in general. We point out the essential differences from background painting and discuss image composition, color intensity, tonal values, lighting, depth effect and color theory. We start with simple color exercises and build these up into concrete painting exercises with trees, shrubs, walls, stones, etc. Later on, we learn and practice mixing sky colors and paint a simpler background image. As a rule, we work with powder paints in beginner courses. However, it is also possible to paint with acrylic paints. Enjoy getting started with "background painting"!
